## **2021 Election Calendar**

### **PRIMARY ELECTION: May 18, 2021**

Last day to register for Primary Election: May 3, 2021

Last day to apply for a mail-in or civilian absentee ballot: May 1, 2021 at 5 PM

### **MUNICIPAL ELECTION: November 2, 2021**

Last day to register for Municipal Election: October 18, 2021

Last day to apply for a mail-in or civilian absentee ballot: October 26, 2021 at 5 PM

All mail in and absentee ballots MUST be received by the Cumberland County Bureau of Elections by 8 PM on Election Day. The Bureau of Elections will remain open until 8 PM on each Election Day.

***Postmarks will NOT be accepted for registration applications and mail-in ballots.***

## **Voting in Pennsylvania**

### **Eligibility:**

1. You are at least 18 years of age on Election Day.

2. You have been a citizen of the United States for at least 30 days prior to Election Day.
3. You are registered to vote in Pennsylvania. The deadline for voter registration is 15 calendar days prior to Election Day.
4. You have been a resident of your current PA election district for at least 30 days prior to the election. If not, you will be required to vote in your previous PA election district (which may be done by mail-in ballot).

### **Registration:**

In order to vote for candidates in PA primary elections, a voter must be registered as either a Republican or a Democrat. **Unaffiliated voters may vote in a primary election ONLY with regard to constitutional amendments, ballot questions, and for special election contests.**

Voter registrations must be updated if the voter has a change of name, address or party affiliation.

PA voter registration closes 15 calendar days prior to each election and reopens 1 day after each election.

1. To register online click on the PA Department of State website, [www.pavoterservicespa.gov](http://www.pavoterservicespa.gov)
2. To register in person (or to make changes to an existing record) go to the Cumberland County Bureau of Elections Office, 1601 Ritner Highway, Suite 201, Carlisle, PA 17013 during regular business hours between 8 AM and 4:30 PM. Due to COVID-19 restrictions Cumberland County offices may only be visited by appointment. To schedule an appointment, you may call or visit the website: <https://www.ccpa.net/66/Bureau-of-Elections>
3. To register by mail complete and return a Registration Form to the address above. Registration forms are available at most Cumberland County post offices, libraries, state liquor stores, and municipal buildings. Registration forms require adequate postage for delivery to the Elections Office. <https://www.ccpa.net/66/Bureau-of-Elections>
4. To register through the DMV, inform your local DMV when you apply for a driver's license or a renewal.

### **Casting a Ballot:**

**In Person** - All voters registered in Pennsylvania may vote in person at a designated polling place. To determine the polling place for their place of residence, voters may contact the Cumberland County Elections Office at 717-240-6385 or go to <https://www.ccpa.net/66/Bureau-of-Elections>.

**By Mail-In Ballot** - In addition to voting in person at a designated polling place, Pennsylvanians may vote using a mail-in ballot. Those who are not absentee voters may apply for a ballot to vote by mail (without stating a reason). To apply for a mail-in ballot, contact the Elections Office (address and phone number above) or download the form at <https://www.ccpa.net/66/Bureau-of-Elections>.

**By Absentee Ballot** - Voters who will be out of their municipalities on election day, and those who have an illness or disability, may vote using an absentee ballot, which requires them to list a reason for their absence. To apply for an absentee ballot, contact the Elections Office (address and phone number above) or download the form at <https://www.ccpa.net/66/Bureau-of-Elections>.
